Senate Scorecard Details

Description of Bills

SF548 – The bill eliminates using state revolving loan fund to acquire land for water quality projects. The Sierra Club opposed the bill; the bill passed and was signed by the governor.

SF237 – This bill changed the membership and procedures of the judicial nominating commission with respect to the selection of judges and changes the term of the chief justice of the Supreme Court. The Sierra Club opposed the bill; however much of the bill were put as an amendment to another bill; that bill and its changes were signed by the governor.

SF583 – SF583 would allow the utility companies to undercut net metering and would institute extra charges for customers with solar panels and wind turbines are billed. The Sierra Club opposed the bill; the bill passed the Senate but was not approved by the House. The original version of the bill was voted on in 2019; that vote is part of the scorecard.

HF692 – The Senate passed HF692 with amendment S3119. The Senate version of the bill has a number of voter suppression items. The Sierra Club opposed the bill; the bill passed the Senate but the House rolled back many of the worst pieces of S3119; the governor signed the House version.

HF767 – HF767 increases the registration fees for electric vehicles, places an excise tax on hydrogen used as special fuel, and institutes an excise tax on electricity used as electric fuel and dispensed through a charging station. The Sierra Club opposed the bill; the bill passed and was signed by the governor.

SF519 – SF519 is known as the ag gag bill (or the anti-whistle blower bill). The Sierra Club opposed the bill; the bill passed and was signed by the governor.

Kayla Lyon confirmation – The Sierra Club opposed the confirmation of Kayla Lyon as Director of the Iowa Department of Natural Resources.

SF2348 – SF2348 places restrictions on the restoration of felon voting rights. The Sierra Club opposed the bill.

SF2392 – SF2392 sets up a committee to review all state boards and to issue recommendations for continuing the board or changing its operations; the board has to bear the burden of justifying its continuance. The Sierra Club opposes the bill.

Description of scoring

The higher the score, the more times the legislator voted with the Sierra Club. If a person took office mid-session, the scorecard counts only the votes taken once the person was seated.

The entries in the table, under each bill are:

YES - The Sierra Club position was to support the bill and the legislator voted in favor of the bill.

yes - The Sierra Club position was to oppose the bill and the legislator voted in favor of the bill.

NO - The Sierra Club position was to oppose the bill and the legislator voted against the bill.

no - The Sierra Club position was to support the bill and the legislator voted against the bill.

Notes about legislators

Senator Eric Giddens was elected during the session, after Senator Jeff Danielson resigned.

Senator Jeff Danielson did not vote on any of the tracked legislation, prior to his resignation.

Description of Bills

H1218 - Amendment H1218 authorizes the State Climatologist to create task forces studying evolving atmospheric conditions and weather patterns on agriculture, making recommendations to the legislature on preventing, mitigating, and adapting to their risks and impacts. The Sierra Club supported the amendment; the amendment failed.

SF548 – The bill eliminates using state revolving loan fund to acquire land for water quality projects. The Sierra Club opposed the bill; the bill passed and was signed by the governor.

HF767 – HF767 increases the registration fees for electric vehicles, places an excise tax on hydrogen used as special fuel, and institutes an excise tax on electricity used as electric fuel and dispensed through a charging station. Of the votes on the scorecard, none of them were taken after Ross Wilburn's appointment.

Representative Andy McKean switched to the Democratic Party during the 2019 legislative session.
