**Sierra Club Statement on Carlos Rubinstein Stepping Down From Texas
Water Development Board**

AUSTIN, Texas – On Tuesday, Carlos Rubinstein, Chair of the Texas Water Development Board, announced he was stepping down after nearly two years.

In response, **Ken Kramer, Water Resources Chair of the Sierra Club's Lone Star Chapter**, issued the following statement:

“Carlos Rubinstein brought a wealth of experience and knowledge in water issues and a good sense of balance to his tenure as chairman of the Texas Water Development Board. His leadership will be missed. At the same time, he was supported by a strong team of fellow Board members and agency staff, and Sierra Club looks forward to continuing to work with that team to advance water conservation and sound water planning for Texas. We hope that Governor Abbott will appoint a strong advocate for water conservation and efficiency to replace Chairman Rubinstein as a member of the Board.”
