You will also receive leadership skills such as...

- Grassroots organizing on campus and in communities, youth-adult partnership work, coalition-building, visibility events and group strengthening
- Basic advocacy skills such as contacting legislators and the media

By the end of the training, you will have the opportunity to take action by...

- Going on an Outreach Event to distribute condoms and/or expose fake clinics, to have fun, and to educate others on the importance of comprehensive reproductive health services.
- Creating an action plan to make a difference on your campus and/or in your community (for example, by hosting an educational event or film showing, contacting a decision-maker, recruiting other volunteers to get involved with an existing campaign, etc.)

Travel scholarships will be available, and we will provide for your lodging and food expenses if you don't live in the Los Angeles area. In addition to the training, there will be several fun outings throughout the weekend.
