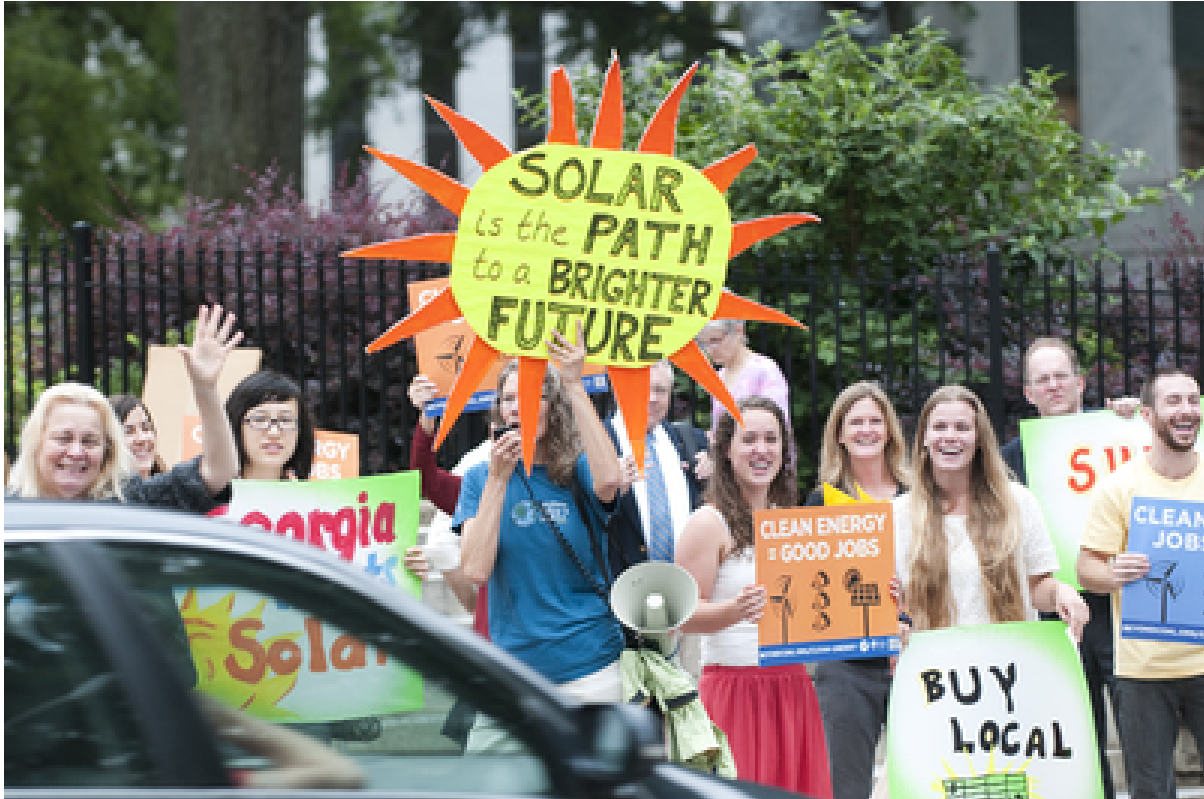

DIRTY DOZEN REPORT RELEASED

This week, Georgia's leading water advocacy organizations released their "Dirty Dozen" for 2018 in a 29-page report highlighting twelve of the worst offenses to Georgia's waters.

Rather than identifying the "most polluted places" in Georgia, the Georgia Water Coalition's (GWC) Dirty Dozen report instead highlights the politics, policies, and issues that threaten the health of Georgia's water and the wellbeing of 10 million Georgians.
