S.6169-A (Cleare)/A.5934-A (Cunningham)

Title: The Voting Integrity and Verification Act of New York (VIVA NY)

Purpose:

To give voters at every poll site the option to mark a paper ballot either by hand or with a ballot marking device (for any voters who prefer to have a machine mark the ballot for them) that is not also a scanner, and to quarantee that all voters can verify the selections on their ballots.

Statement of Support:

This bill will codify and reinforce our current system of hand-marked paper ballots.

Voting machine manufacturers are aggressively offering new machines with touchscreens that mark ballots, which the voter is supposed to verify before then inserting into a scanner. Use of these machines presents several problems:

- Studies show that many voters don't take the time to verify a ballot they did not mark themselves;
- Should these machines displace our current hand-marking of ballots, long lines could ensue;
- The new machines are expensive, and significantly less affordable for poorer jurisdictions.
- The overuse of these machines could lead to the effective end of hand-marked paper ballots.

Clearly preserving our current mode of voting, without complication or hassle, is the best way to encourage voter confidence in our elections.
