WisCorps - Training Future Leaders in Wisconsin's Workforce

Speaker: Matthew Brantner, Executive Director, WisCorps, Inc.

WisCorps is a statewide 501(c)(3) non-profit conservation corps that engages youth and young adults between the ages of 16 and 25 on conservation and community revitalization projects across the state of Wisconsin and upper Midwest. They use hands-on projects that include habitat restoration, invasive species management, trail rehabilitation, streambank stabilization, bridge construction, and other high priority



conservation objectives as a vehicle for developing the skills needed for our youth to become future leaders in Wisconsin's Workforce.
