## **Missouri Chapter Retreat**

This program is a move to attract members from a wider range of ethnic backgrounds.

## **Eleven Point River Clean-up**

This event will be held on the weekend of July 14th. It is a joint event of the Sierra Club and Operation Clean Stream. The plan is for several crews to clean up 48 miles of the river.

The consensus seemed to be that we should develop an approach for calling this problem to the attention of our leaders and for encouraging them to lead one or two weekend outings.

## **OLT 201 Training**

Doug M. recently reviewed the online OLT-201 course. It was mostly about how to handle people and interaction situations that might arise. There was little about outdoor skills. The book "Outdoor Leadership" addresses many of the same issues as the course. Doug M. thinks it might be a good idea to offer this training if there is enough interest among our leaders.

#### **October Trails Work Week**

Doug M. is now the contact person for the October Trails Week event. It will be held October 6-14.

## **Outings for November and December**

Mark S. will be out of town most of August and part of September. Doug will be handling outings scheduling during that period.

## **First Aid Training**

We have around 15 leaders that need first aid training. Doug M. is tentatively planning this for September. He needs to arrange for rental of CPR dummies.

#### Meetup

Paul O. asked about the value of continuing the outings Meetup program. Meetup hasn't resulted in very many new participants or members. Doug M. feels that Meetup may be useful for attracting new people when we expand weekend outings. Paul O. also pointed out that the non-outings EMG Meetup site is not being kept up to date and he feels that this reflects badly on the EMG.
