The maps below are to help with directions after you arrive on the roads near the site's entrance. Call 804-647-8130 if interested in carpooling from Science Museum of VA.



Volunteer Now for the Big Yard Sale at the University of Richmond

NOW is the time to volunteer for the fantastic Big Yard Sale at University of Richmond! This recycling effort involves a huge volunteer team that starts now to collect and sort items discarded by students as they leave campus--all in preparation for the

Big Yard Sale on May 18. It's a great example of reduce/reuse/recycle!

Last year's Big Yard Sale was a great success in every way -- diverting good stuff from the landfill, donating leftover items to Goodwill Industries, meeting other volunteers, and generating over \$15,000 shared by FOJG and the University of Richmond (UR). Proceeds benefit educational programs at the University of Richmond as well as the Sierra Club's Falls of the James Group.

In 2018, we successfully transitioned the sale from Millhiser Gym, which is being re-purposed into a training facility, to the concourse in front of Robins Stadium, a space one third smaller than the Millhiser Gym. Because of the smaller space we now presort goods during Early Collection to minimize sorting needed on Collection Day. Here are the important dates:

Collection Day, Monday, May 13th, is our biggest volunteer day, as <u>eighty</u> volunteers are needed to begin organizing in the sale space.
