



YORK COUNTY AIR POLLUTION HEALTH FACTS

According to the American Lung Association, 201,876 York County residents (including 42,452 children and 30,512 adults ages 65 and older) are at-risk for chronic respiratory and pulmonary illnesses such as asthma, chronic bronchitis, emphysema, and cardiovascular disease.

ASTHMA IMPACTS ON YORK COUNTY RESIDENTS

Maine's Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) reports that in York County:

- 16 percent of 5th and 6th graders, and nearly 8 percent of adults were diagnosed with asthma in 2009
- 630 people were hospitalized due to asthma from 2004-2008
- Nearly 1140 emergency department visits were due to asthma in 2008
- 10 residents died due to asthma between 1999 and 2008
