Green tech companies take center stage in Queen City

Renewable energy and green technology companies in New Hampshire showcased their work at a special edition of New Hampshire Innovation Nights on August 6. Innovation Nights have been hosted on an occasional basis since November at the AlphaLoft, a business incubator designed to help startups. This event was timed to coincide with, and celebrate, the announcement of the Clean Power Plan by President Obama. The plan calls for significant reductions in carbon emissions from power plants between now and 2030.

organization, and was sponsored by the New Hampshire Clean Tech Council, the League of Conservation Voters, NH Sierra Club, Union of Concerned Scientists, Mom's Clean Air Force and National Wildlife Federation. Milly's Tavern and Stark Brewing Co., and the Bridge Cafe, hosted the event and provided refreshments.

Several companies were picked by an online vote to pitch their products to the over 100 attendees. The exhibitors chosen were Heet Meter (35 Votes), LighTec (12 Votes), Anar (16 Votes), and GXTracker (11 Votes).

Three companies were chosen by audience vote as the night's top exhibitors. These were <u>Revision</u> <u>Energy</u>, first prize, <u>Anar Solar</u>, second, <u>Therma-Hexx</u>, third.
