DESCRIPTION:

The Sierra Club Environmental Law Program in the Washington, DC office is seeking recent law school graduates interested in public interest, environmental litigation to assist with its strategic lawsuits. The DC office is largely focused on climate change related litigation, including litigation related to all parts of the lifecycle of the use of coal, oil, and natural gas for energy generation, as well as energy efficiency and renewable energy expansion. Fellows work on all aspects of litigation, including undertaking legal research, preparing written memoranda, and conducting factual investigation. Fellows may also draft notice letters, briefs and other pleadings, attend court appearances, and work on discovery. During the course of the program, fellows work with several of the Club's attorneys, thus gaining exposure to a wide range of litigation styles.

The Sierra Club is the nation's oldest grassroots environmental organization as well as the nation's leader in environmental litigation. The Environmental Law Program directs legal strategy for the Sierra Club's climate recovery campaigns and chapters. The Program's docket covers a diversity of environmental issues, from local pollution issues to cases of national significance on greenhouse gases, toxic pollution, clean air, clean water, and wilderness preservation.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Recent law school graduates who have excellent writing and analytic skills, and demonstrated interest in environmental advocacy and public interest. In addition, applicants should be highly motivated, have good interpersonal skills, and be able to exercise professional judgment and maturity.
