 - Infrastructure damage and potential fires
- Five Criteria for PSPS Activation
 - Red Flag Warning

- Low Humidity Levels (<20%)
- Forecast sustained winds 25 mph w/gusts > 45 mph
- Dry fuel on the ground
- PG&E on-the-ground real time observations


