Honorable Mayor and Members of the City Council,

Thank you for reducing speed limits around schools to 15 mph as recommended by AB 321/22358.4 of the California Vehicle Code like Sacramento, Oakland, and San Jose yesterday. Lower speed limits make the city more pleasant and safe for residents. At 15 mph, most pedestrians will survive a crash, sustaining only minor injuries. Fifteen mph makes it safer to be outside and reduces emissions including greenhouse gases from automobiles by more than 30%. The slower speed also increases the field of vision making nighttime driving much safer.
