HF248	Changes cycle for electric power generating facility emission plans and projects for coal fired power plants by removing the 2 year requirement and allowing updates, also allows advanced rate-making.	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. The bill was passed by the Senate and the House. It was signed by governor.
HF317	Allows killing raccoons, opossum, or skunks if the landowner or tenant deems the animal to be a nuisance, without prior permission from DNR.	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. The bill was passed by the Senate and the House. It was signed by governor.
HF565	Pipeline easement requirements and landowner rights regarding pipeline construction. Requires 90% of route miles as voluntary easements. Expands damages that constitute compensable loss to include soil compaction, damage to soil or water conservation structures, damage to irrigation or drainage systems. Creates and interim study committee on eminent domain.	The Sierra Club supported this bill. The bill was passed by the House.
HF572	Prohibits flying drones over animal feeding operations.	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. The bill was passed by the House.
HF605	Forbids energy benchmarking of private property and requiring use of less energy.	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. The bill was passed by the Senate and the House. It was signed by governor.
HF716	Requires that members voting at precinct caucuses must be in attendance.	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. The bill was passed by the Senate and the House. It was signed by governor.
SF171	Changes membership on the Judicial Nominating Commission for district courts from 5 nominated by the governor and 5 by the attorneys to 6 nominated by the governor and 5 by the attorneys. Removes the district's chief judge at the head of the commission and replaces it with the commission selecting its own chair.	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. The bill was passed by the Senate.
SF455	Prohibits counties and cities from requiring topsoil restoration at building sites, counties and cities cannot require more stringent storm water runoff at a construction site than is present before construction begins.	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. The bill was passed by the Senate.
SF478	Affects the state auditor's access to information and lays out the dispute process.	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. The bill was passed by the Senate and the House. It was signed by governor.
SF507	ESG ban. The general assembly is deeply concerned over the increased prevalence of investing based on social and environmental factors, known as environmental, social, and governance investing, rather than pecuniary factors. Therefore, the general assembly intends to ensure that state funds and funds administered by the state, including public employee retirement funds, are protected from political influence detrimental to the	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. Reduces \$500,000 from the Iowa Nutrient Research Fund to an Iowa Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship fund supporting soil conservation and water quality which reduces funding for water pollution sensors. Description of scoring

The higher the score, the more times the legislator voted with the Sierra Club. If a person took office mid-session, the scorecard counts only the votes taken once the person was seated.

The calculation of the score is:

$$\text{Score} = 100 * (\# \text{ voting with Sierra Club} / (\text{total votes on score card} - \# \text{ absent or not voting}))$$

The entries in the table, under each bill are:

AYE - The Sierra Club position was to support the bill and the legislator voted in favor of the bill.

aye - The Sierra Club position was to oppose the bill and the legislator voted in favor of the bill.

NAY - The Sierra Club position was to oppose the bill and the legislator voted against the bill.

nay - The Sierra Club position was to support the bill and the legislator voted against the bill.

A – absent or did not vote

Blank – person was not sitting as a legislator when the bill was voted on.
