

Migration

Many Native Peoples moved or migrated seasonally to access improved shelter and food sources. People who live in greater harmony with the land offer important perspectives in the struggle to protect wildlife and the environment. One recommendation is to create more corridors which connect wildlife populations. Corridors allow for migration and are especially important during Global Warming when animals which traditionally live at certain elevations and locations need to move away from dryer and hotter areas which no longer meet their needs. Connecting Public and Private Lands and building safer highway crossings are ways to help animals migrate.
