Dr. Curtis talked about the work of the recently endowed Center for Climate Studies at the Citadel.

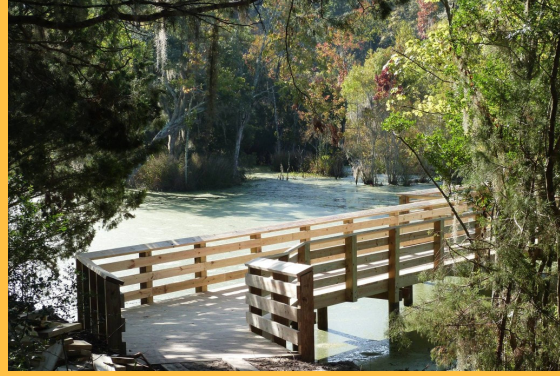
