IOWA ORDINANCES



9 counties in Iowa have passed a carbon pipeline zoning ordinance with setback distances, conditional use permits, and more.



Summit Carbon Solutions has sued or threatened suit against counties that have passed an ordinance. The lawsuits are on going. Summit refuses to release any safety information.



The proposed pipeline routes are near dozens of Iowa towns, hundreds of homes and within 2 miles of 47 schools.



SAFETY

Summit has refused to publicize their safety information, even to first responders. Our first responders are not prepared and are not being told the truth about the dangers of carbon pipelines. In the event of a rupture, first responders will not be instructed to rescue anyone, they will cordon off an area and tell people to shelter in place.



PROTECT LOCAL CONTROL

PHMSA determined Counties and States do have the authority over siting: "the responsibility for siting new carbon dioxide pipelines rests largely with the individual states and counties through which the pipelines will operate and is governed by state and local law."



TAKE ACTION

1. Contact your County Supervisors and ask them to pass a carbon pipeline ordinance.
2. Contact your legislators and ask them to vote yes on SF2097, a bill that protects carbon pipeline county ordinances and more.
