



Volunteer With the Moshannon Group!

Here is a sampling of the Moshannon Group's activities:

- Hikes and outings celebrating our region's natural resources and maintaining a section of the Mid-State Trail;
- Participation in local Earth Day Celebrations and watershed cleanups;
- Conservation and climate crisis education programs such as the monthly Lunch and Learn focused on Reducing Your Carbon Footprint;
- Working with local municipalities to achieve 100% renewable energy by 2050 and other environmental sustainability measures;
- Advocating for the Centre Region Solar Power Purchase Agreement;
- Working with partners to protect Old Crow Wetland in Huntingdon from proposed development;
- Working to identify and list orphaned and abandoned gas wells to be plugged;
- PFAS monitoring of surface waters in the Spring and Bald Eagle Creek watersheds with the Centre County PA Senior Environmental Corps;
- Work with local and state officials to protect water resources from improper stormwater management at a proposed mega-warehouse.
- Advocating against the destruction of farmland and wildlife habitat as a result of proposed PA 322 Connector;
- Participation with the PA Climate Action Group in public actions to raise awareness of the climate crisis;
- Identifying local candidates for Sierra Club endorsement;
- Educating residents on how to make the Inflation Reduction Act benefits work for them (solar, electric vehicles, etc.).
- Advocacy and education of air pollution issues vital to PA: ozone smog, acid precipitation, power plant emissions of mercury and fine particle breathable soot, and methane.
- Support for local organizations such as Penns Valley Conservation Association, Centre County Farmland Trust, and Clearwater Conservancy.
