HF639	An omnibus bill relating to hazardous liquid pipelines - common carrier requirements; proceedings under the Iowa utilities commission, including commission member attendance at hearings and informational meetings, including allowing certain persons to intervene in such proceedings, including sanctions on intervenors in contested cases, and prohibiting permit renewal; insurance requirements	The Sierra Club supported this bill. The House passed it 85-10. The Senate passed it 27-22. The governor vetoed this bill.
HF943	Precludes eminent domain for hazardous liquid pipeline on agriculture land	The Sierra Club supported this bill. The House passed it 82-12.
HF989	Regulations for on-farm anaerobic digesters	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. The House passed it 80-13.
SF394	Provides civil liability protection for pesticide manufacturers. The label provides sufficient warning if it complies with any one of 3 criteria: 1: it was approved by the EPA, 2: it is consistent with the most recent human health assessment performed under the federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, 3: it is consistent with EPA's carcinogenicity classification for the pesticide	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. The Senate passed it 26-21.
SF407	Changes membership in judicial nominating commissions – Governor would get to appoint 6 of the 11 commissioners instead of 5, the most senior judge in the district would be removed from the commission, commission members would select their own chair	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. The Senate passed it 31-15.
SF491	Regulates flying of drones over farmland and sets criminal penalties	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. The House passed it 89-7. The Senate passed it 42-8. The governor signed this bill.
SF588	Changes the public notice requirements for cities and counties, affects zoning and revitalization hearings. Includes other notice requirements.	The Sierra Club supported this bill. The House passed it 88-8.
SF633	Forest and fruit tree reservations will be assessed property tax based on location of the reservation and where owner maintains a homestead	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. The Senate passed it 31-14.
SF75	Dictates that counties with the main campus of an institution of higher learning governed by the state board of regents (ISU, UNI, UI) elect members to the Board of Supervisors following Plan 3. Further counties with 60,000 or more residents can switch from plan 3 with a 2/3 vote held during a special election. Plan 3 requires individual members of the board of supervisors to be elected from single-member, equal-population districts. This singles out Johnson, Black Hawk, and Story Counties/	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. The Senate passed it 35-12. The House passed it 65-33. The governor signed this bill.
SJR11	A constitutional amendment requiring tax increases to individual and corporate income tax rates be made by a two-thirds vote of both chambers – normal majority vote on lowering taxes	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. The Senate passed it 32-15.

Description of scoring

The higher the score, the more times the legislator voted with the Sierra Club. If a person took office mid-session, the scorecard counts only the votes taken once the person was seated.

The calculation of the score is:

$$\text{Score} = 100 * (\# \text{ voting with Sierra Club} / (\text{total votes on score card} - \# \text{ absent or not voting}))$$

The entries in the table, under each bill are:

- AYE - The Sierra Club position was to support the bill and the legislator voted in favor of the bill.
- aye - The Sierra Club position was to oppose the bill and the legislator voted in favor of the bill.
- NAY - The Sierra Club position was to oppose the bill and the legislator voted against the bill.
- nay - The Sierra Club position was to support the bill and the legislator voted against the bill.
- A – absent or did not vote
- Blank – person was not sitting as a legislator when the bill was voted on.

The Sierra Club's position on the bill is shown on the first line of the chart.
