HF2104	Would ban the use of eminent domain for CO2 pipelines	The Sierra Club supported this bill. House passed it 64-28.
HF2527 HF2527	Places a limitation on civil or criminal liability for damages caused by climate change; it is a way for the oil and gas industry to avoid responsibility for climate change	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. House passed it 66-24. Senate passed it 33-13. The governor signed the bill.
HF2618	Eliminates smart planning principles from required consideration in local zoning actions and in developing comprehensive plans	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. House passed it 72-25
HF2717	Overhauls rulemaking process for major rules, include those that have significant adverse impacts on competition, employment, investment, productivity, innovation, individual industries or regions, implementation of the Clean Air Act. This is also called "The Reins Act".	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. House passed it 60-32.
HF853	Defines how courts interpret statutes and rules in court proceedings – de novo. The bill has technical problems.	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. House passed it 76-19.
SF2434	Restricts cities and counties from implementing rules unless they have been approved by the council or supervisors as part of an ordinance. Any ordinance is to be accompanied with an analysis of costs to taxpayers and businesses and economic impacts.	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. Senate passed it 31-14.
SF2463	Moves most state agencies to uniform rules, for rulemaking, petitions for rulemaking, waiver of rules, declaratory orders, contested cases, and fair information practices.	The Sierra Club supported this bill. Senate passed it 30-15. Governor signed the bill.
SF2490	Creates framework and regulations for drilling for natural hydrogen. Forces landowners into pooling if they are less than 25% of landowners above the pool of hydrogen. Allows Department of Natural Resources to waive those rules and regulations, without a public hearing at the request of the hydrogen company.	The Sierra Club opposed this bill. Senate passed it 32-15. The bill passed both chambers.

Description of scoring

The higher the score, the more times the legislator voted with the Sierra Club. If a person took office mid-session, the scorecard counts only the votes taken once the person was seated.

The calculation of the score is:

$$\text{Score} = 100 * (\# \text{ voting with Sierra Club} / (\text{total votes on score card} - \# \text{ absent or not voting}))$$

The entries in the table, under each bill are:

- AYE - The Sierra Club position was to support the bill and the legislator voted in favor of the bill.
- aye - The Sierra Club position was to oppose the bill and the legislator voted in favor of the bill.
- NAY - The Sierra Club position was to oppose the bill and the legislator voted against the bill.
- nay - The Sierra Club position was to support the bill and the legislator voted against the bill.
- A – absent or did not vote
- Blank – person was not sitting as a legislator when the bill was voted on.

The Sierra Club's position on the bill is shown on the first line of the chart.
