Q1 How much have you seen, heard or read recently about the Keystone XL pipeline proposal: a lot, some, just a little, or nothing at all?

A lot..... 30%
Some 41%
Just a little..... 21%
Nothing at all..... 7%

Q2 As you may already know, the proposed Keystone XL pipeline would carry tar sands oil from Alberta, Canada through Nebraska, South Dakota, and Montana to the Gulf Coast where it would likely be refined and the majority of it exported. Based on what you know, do you strongly favor, somewhat favor, somewhat oppose or strongly oppose the Keystone XL pipeline?
