## Proposed GRI, Terminal Tariff No. 5

| Tariff | Item | Subject   | Adjustment Type |
|--------|------|---|-----------------|
| 5      | 605  | Taking, Releasing and Shifting Lines                              | Longshore       |
| 5      | 610  | Connecting and Disconnecting Hoses, Booster Pumps and Accessories | Longshore       |



## Recommendation

Port staff recommends that the Port Director:

- Approve the proposed General Rate Increase to items in the Port of Stockton's Terminal Tariff No. 5
- 2. Authorize Port staff to submit the proposed change in Tariff to the California Association of Port Authorities (CAPA) to secure the General Rate Increase approval
- 3. Upon confirmation of CAPA's approval, authorize Port Staff to amend Port of Stockton Terminal Tariff No. 5 to reflect rate changes with the effective date of July 1, 2020
