Recommendation

Port staff recommends that the Port Director:

1. Approve the proposed General Rate Increase to items in the Port of Stockton's Terminal Tariff No. 5
2. Authorize Port staff to submit the proposed change in Tariff to the California Association of Port Authorities (CAPA) to secure the General Rate Increase approval
3. Upon confirmation of CAPA's approval, authorize Port Staff to amend Port of Stockton Terminal Tariff No. 5 to reflect rate changes with the effective date of July 1, 2020
