## WEEK IN REVIEW

Today is the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of the 90 day 2019 legislative session.

This week the Legislature conducted half day floor debate on General File bills and half day committee hearings.

On Tuesday, February 5, 2019 the Unicameral held hearings on three bills of interest to the Sierra Club. The Urban Affairs Committee heard Senator Kolterman's **LB 23** PRO (Change the Property Assessed Clean Energy Act) and Senator Crawford's **LB 124** PRO(Change provisions relating to jointly created clean energy assessment districts under the Property Assessed Clean Energy Act). The Transportation and Telecommunications Committee heard Senator Cavanaugh's **LB 691** PRO (Provide for Ornate Box Turtle Conservation license plates).

The Sierra Club testified in favor of LB 23; and during that hearing expressly supported LB 124. Sierra Club testified that LB 23 made multiple desirable changes and suggested a change to the provisions of the bill PACE. LB23 added water efficiency to the existing energy efficiency criteria, expanded the list of certifiers of efficiency, and permitted property tax assessment adjustments after initiating a project rather than only prior to initiating a project. The Sierra Club suggestd not adding economic development to resource efficiency as authorized basis for access to PACE funding. The Sierra Club supported LB 124's increasing the flexibility for local governments seeking to use PACE, authorizing multiple jurisdiction collaborations and authorizing subdivisions of local government to engage in PACE.

The Sierra Club sought the introduction of Senator Cavanaugh's LB 691. The committee heard six bills proposing new specialty license plates. There was no testimony in opposition LB 691. Joining the Sierra Club in proponent testimony was the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission, the National Wildlife Federation, and the Audubon Society. LB 691 differed from other wildlife license plate bills (i.e., existing mountain lion plate and NG&PC's requested LB 128 (Hughes) "Provide for Wildlife Conservation Plates") all of which direct funds raised to the amorphous NG&PC's Education Cash Fund. LB 691 directs funds to the Wildlife Conservation Fund which has a habitat focus. The Sierra Club urged the committee to amend the mountain lion fees and the LB 128 fees into the Wildlife Conservation Fund. NG&PC resisted this but, that suggestion was supported by the National Wildlife Federation and the Audubon Society. Everyone supported LB 691 creating a dedicated cash flow for non-game species and habitat since currently the NG&PC does not have any such dedicated funds. The Sierra Club urged limiting license plates to species native to Nebraska, the NG&PC did not reject that idea but did contest that no trout was native.

The committee took no action on any of the license plate bills.

On Monday February 11<sup>th</sup> **LB283** (PRO Pansing Brooks) "Provide for a climate change study" will be heard in the Executive Board. We will testify in favor of **LB283** "

On Tuesday February 12<sup>th</sup> **LB665** (MON Friesen) "Authorize the use of electric foot scooters" will have a hearing in the Transportation and Telecommunications Committee.

Next Friday February 15th and the following Monday February 18th will be recess days.

On Thursday February 21 **LB621** (PRO Kolowski) "Change provisions relating to solar energy and wind energy, declare certain instruments void and unenforceable, and provide for a civil cause of action" will be heard in the Natural Resources Committee.

Tuesday February 26<sup>th</sup> **LB51** (PRO Vargas) "Change license applications, prohibited acts, and franchise restrictions under the Motor Vehicle Industry Regulation Act" and **LB366** (ANTI Bostelman) "Change registration fee for alternative fuel-powered motor vehicles" will have a hearing in the Transportation and Telecommunications Committee.

On Tuesday March 5<sup>th</sup> **LB401** (PRO Quick) "Adopt the Midwest Interstate Passenger Rail Compact" will be heard in the Transportation and Telecommunications Committee.

On Thursday March 14<sup>th</sup> **LB509** (PRO McCollister) "Redefine the terms net metering and qualified facility and change powers and duties of a local distribution utility" will be heard in the Natural Resources Committee. We will testify in favor of LB509.
