## **WEEK IN REVIEW**

Today, Friday, March 1st is the 34th day of the 90 day 2019 legislative session.

The Legislature continues to devote its efforts to conducting half day floor debate on bills out of committees (first on General File, then Select File, then Final Reading) and devoting half-days to committee hearings. Committee hearings are expected to continue until the end of March.

Not yet on the Clerk's official list of hearing dates, but understood as "scheduled" by the committee clerks are two bills of great interest to the Sierra Club. **LB678** (Vargas) on the **VW settlement** is scheduled for Wednesday, March 20<sup>th</sup>. **LB509** (McCollister) on **net metering** is scheduled for Thursday, March 14<sup>th</sup>.

This last week was busy as the pace of legislative activity is picking up. We provided testimony on four bills of interest to the Sierra Club. **LB51** PRO Vargas "Change license applications, prohibited acts, and franchise restrictions under the Motor Vehicle Industry Regulation Act" (a.k.a., Tesla bill); and **LB366** PRO Bostelman "Change registration fee for alternative fuel-powered motor vehicles", both in the Transportation and Telecommunications Committee. **LB157** PRO Brewer "Provide for voluntary registration, duties for the Department of Agriculture, and a cause of action under the Nebraska Apiary Act" in the Agriculture Committee. **LB492** PRO Wayne "Adopt the Regional Metropolitan Transit Authority Act" in the Urban Affairs Committee. Clyde Anderson authored the testimony for **LB492**. All testimony is attached.

Action on the floor included the following. On Wednesday February 27<sup>th</sup>, a significant success was experienced when **LB155 ANTI** Brewer "Change eminent domain provisions that apply to privately developed renewable energy generation facilities" **did not** advance from General File. **LB155** failed to obtain the needed 25 votes, failing on a very odd vote of 23 yes, 8 no, 14 present not voting, 3 excused not voting, and 1 absent not voting. Senator McCollister led the opposition and many of our friends were in the "not voting" categories. Lastly, **LB302** ANTI Hughes "Merge the State Energy Office with and rename the Department of Environmental Quality" (and have the state take over from the feds wet lands permitting) was placed on Final Reading.
