RE: Nebraska 2017 Legislative Session, Week Ending May 26, 2017

## **SESSION IN REVIEW**

The Legislature adjourned sine die on May 23, 2017 on Day 86 of the scheduled 90-day session.

This 2017 session was relatively short (86 of 90 days) and unproductive (26% of bills passed vs. the usual 33%) by historical standards.

There were 17 new lawmakers this session, as first-year senators filled more than one-third of the Legislature's 49 seats. Roughly 70% of this year's senators have two years of experience or less, due mostly to Nebraska's term limits. Thirty-two registered Republicans, 15 Democrats, one independent, and one Libertarian composed the officially non-partisan Legislature this session.

The freshman class of largely conservative members set the tone early on by sweeping the Speaker's office and all but one of the coveted committee chairmanships. Committees are often referred to as "the other house" in Nebraska's Unicameral, so the leadership of these committees is highly sought after and influential.

The need to pass an \$8.8 billion two-year budget hung over the session from the first day to the last. Revenue forecast estimates and actual receipts continued to be revised downward, making the pressure on the Appropriations Committee to craft a budget even harder. The body eventually passed on to the governor a budget with 1% average annual growth. The Governor line-item vetoed \$56.5 million in additional spending. The Legislature did not override any vetoes.

Of the 667 bills introduced this session, the Governor approved 170. There were 107 priority bills and 71 of them passed. One priority bill (LB75) passed the Legislature but was vetoed by the Governor. A copy of the final worksheet is <u>attached</u>.

Sierra Club took a position in support of 18 bills this session and in opposition to three.

Of the bills supported by Sierra Club, three were approved by the Governor.

-LB97 (*Crawford* Adopt the Riverfront Development District Act) adopts the Riverfront Development District Act to authorize cities to create riverfront development districts to effectively fund, manage, promote, and develop riverfronts within city limits.

-LB339 (*Friesen* Merge the Department of Aeronautics into the Department of Roads and rename as the Department of Transportation) creates the Nebraska Department of



Transportation, which consists of the Department of Aeronautics and the Department of Roads.

-LB584 (*Friesen* Change provisions relating to mowing of weeds along roads) amends the duty of landowners to mow roadside vegetation.

LB39 (*Harr* Prohibit the sale and trade of ivory) advanced from the Judiciary Committee and has been placed on General File.

Nine bills supported by Sierra Club remain in committee:

- -LB218 (Groene Provide for installation of ground water pumps by public entities)
- -LB392 (*Larson* Adopt the Wind Friendly Counties Act)
- -LB412 (*Bolz* Provide duties for the state investment officer relating to investment in energy-related companies or funds)
- -LB448 (*Chambers* Eliminate provisions relating to the hunting of mountain lions)
- -LB449 (Chambers Repeal the Black-Tailed Prairie Dog Management Act)
- -LB499 (*Brewer* Provide for voluntary registration and duties for the Department of Agriculture under the Nebraska Apiary Act as prescribed)
- -LB504 (*Brewer* Provide for a moratorium on industrial development of wind energy projects and for a task force study as prescribed)
- -LB610 (Kolowski Adopt the Community Solar Energy Economic Development Act)
- -LB646 (*Pansing Brooks* Provide for an extreme weather preparedness task force and strategic action plan)

Five bills supported by Sierra Club have been indefinitely postponed:

- -LB87 (*Blood* Redefine a qualified facility and authorize local distribution utilities to waive certain requirements relating to net metering)
- -LB352 (Vargas Adopt the Wind, Solar, and Fuel Cell Business Financing Act)
- -LB429 (Wishart Provide for virtual net metering)
- -LB488 (*Groene* Adopt the Water Conservation Grant Act)
- -LB626 (*Larson* Adopt the Shared Community Solar Act)

Of the bills opposed by Sierra Club, none passed. Two of the bills have been indefinitely postponed: LB657 (*Wishart* Adopt the Retail Electricity Transparency Act) and LB660 (*Wayne* Adopt the Nebraska Retail Electricity Choice Act and remove a restriction on the sale or delivery of retail electricity by a private electric supplier). LB494 (*Briese* Provide for withholding public records relating to energy infrastructure) advanced from the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee, but remains on General File.

Senators introduced 126 interim study resolutions this session. A list of all interim studies introduced is attached.

Interim Studies of Interest include:

LR4 (Blood) Interim study to explore if the development of a more comprehensive water quality study is needed

LR125 (Hughes) Interim study to examine public power in Nebraska

LR211 (Wayne) Interim study to examine giving consumers a choice among electricity supply options and greater information concerning their service and billing options

LR239 (Kolowski) Interim study to examine issues related to solar energy development in Nebraska

LR243 (Wayne) Interim study to examine issues related to eminent domain and property rights

LR245 (Brewer) Interim study to examine issues raised by LB504, 2017, related to placing a moratorium on industrial development of wind energy projects

## **BILLS OF SPECIAL INTEREST**

LB412 (Bolz – Provide duties for the state investment officer relating to investment in energy-related companies or funds) was heard in the Nebraska Retirement Systems Committee on February 21, 2017. LB412 remains in committee. Indications are that the state investment officer will provide a report containing the information required in LB412. Support

LB533 (Vargas – Require liability insurance for and restrict locations of underground enhanced recovery injection wells and wastewater disposal wells) was indefinitely postponed on March 7, 2017. This effectively kills LB533 for 2017. **Support**
