We'll stop along the Combahee River, site of Harriet Tubman's raid in 1863, before continuing on to the [Reconstruction Era National Historic Park](#) in Beaufort and the [Penn Center](#) on St Helena Island. With time, we'll finish the day with a visit to Hunting Island State Park for some important beachcombing.
