Known to some as the country's second Independence Day, Juneteenth celebrates the freedom of enslaved people in the United States at the end of the Civil War. We'll stop along the Combahee River, site of Harriet Tubman's raid in 1863, before continuing on to the Reconstruction Era National Historic Park in Beaufort and the Penn Center on St Helena Island. With time, we'll finish the day with a visit to Hunting Island State Park for some important beachcombing.
