We are reaching out to you today to ask for your leadership and support, as San Antonio takes a monumental step forward to become a climate ready community. The scientific community is in consensus that climate change is occurring and it is in the best interest of our city to address this challenge head-on. While climate change is a global issue, its impact is felt at the local level. From more extreme weather pattern such as heat, drought and flooding, we have an opportunity now to be proactive in how we build, how we establish future transit plans and how we manage our natural resources. The work that we do today will help keep San Antonio safe, competitive and more equitable.

As we undertake the development of our climate planning roadmap, called SA Climate Ready, we have partnered with CPS Energy and UTSA, and need leaders like you to help develop a plan to move San Antonio forward.
