
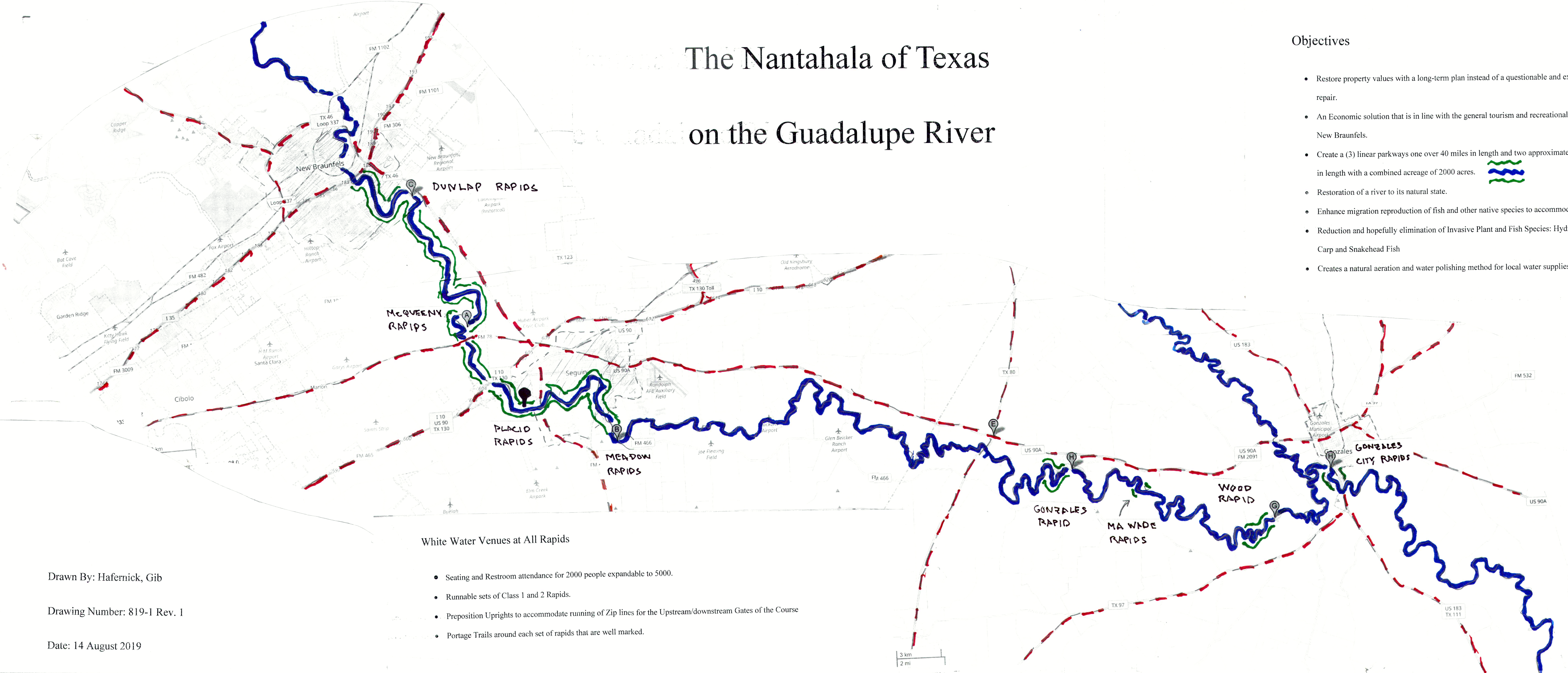


The Nantahala of Texas

Objectives

- Restore property values with a long-term plan instead of a questionable and expensive repair.
- An Economic solution that is in line with the general tourism and recreational values of New Braunfels.
- Create a (3) linear parkways one over 40 miles in length and two approximately 8 miles in length with a combined acreage of 2000 acres. 
- Restoration of a river to its natural state.
- Enhance migration reproduction of fish and other native species to accommodate fishing.
- Reduction and hopefully elimination of Invasive Plant and Fish Species: Hydrilla, Asian Carp and Snakehead Fish
- Creates a natural aeration and water polishing method for local water supplies.

- Runnable sets of Class 1 and 2 Rapids.
- Preposition Uprights to accommodate running of Zip lines for the Upstream/downstream Gates of the Course
- Portage Trails around each set of rapids that are well marked.
