TAR SANDS pipeline update - Exciting News...One of our E. Texas cities HAS established a 391 Commission which can ask TransCanada/Keystone to make provisions if their pipeline is approved.

The House of Representatives passed a bill trying to make the Obama Administration set a deadline on the approval of the pipeline, but it was declared DEAD on arrival at the Senate.

TCEQ Air Hearing- At least 110 people went to the TCEQ Air SIP Hearing to testify or be there in support of the effort. The media did show for the evening press conference of Downwinders.
