Sierra Club Mission:

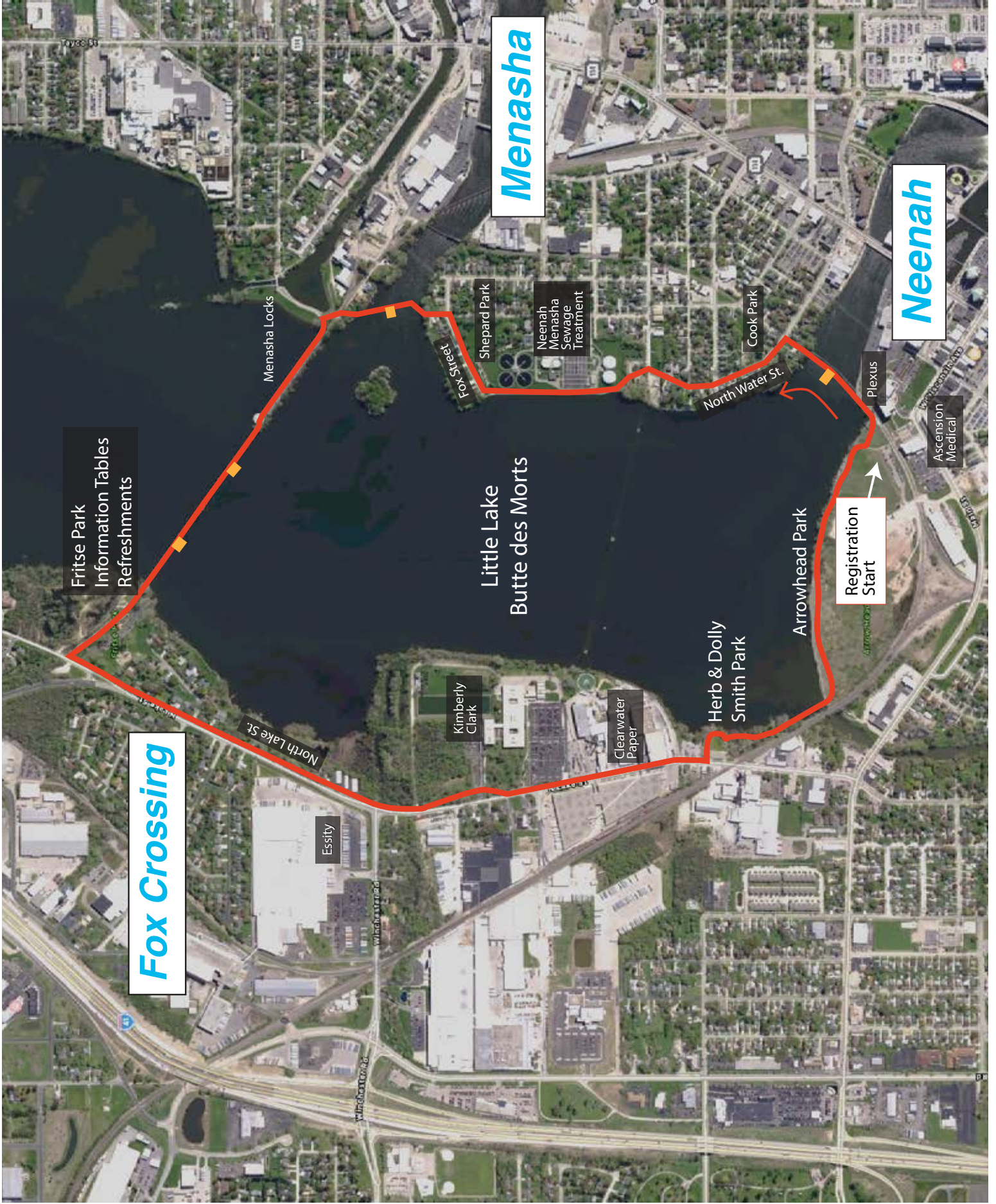
Explore, enjoy, and protect the planet.
