Section 1. Section 455B.109, subsection 1, unnumbered 1 2 paragraph 1, Code 2018, is amended to read as follows: The commission shall establish, by rule, a schedule or range 4 of civil penalties which may be administratively assessed. 5 The schedule shall provide procedures and criteria for the 6 administrative assessment of penalties of not more than ten 7 twenty-five thousand dollars for violations of this chapter or 8 rules, permits, or orders adopted or issued under this chapter. 9 In adopting a schedule or range of penalties and in proposing 10 or assessing a penalty, the commission and director shall 11 consider among other relevant factors the following: 12 **EXPLANATION** 13 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly. 14 15 This bill relates to a schedule established by the 16 environmental protection commission for civil penalties. 17 Currently, the environmental protection commission is 18 required to establish a schedule or range of civil penalties of 19 not more than \$10,000 that may be administratively assessed. 20 Currently, if a civil penalty is more than \$10,000, the civil 21 penalty is not administratively assessed. 22 The bill increases the maximum administratively assessed 23 civil penalty amount from \$10,000 to \$25,000.
