A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act regulating the application of certain pesticides in
- 2 proximity to a child care facility or school, and making
- 3 penalties applicable.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 206.2, Code 2019, is amended by adding
- 2 the following new subsections:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 6A. "Child care facility" means the same
- 4 as defined in section 237A.1.
- 5 NEW SUBSECTION. 11A. "Drift" means the movement of a
- 6 pesticide during or immediately after application through air
- 7 to a site other than the intended site of application.
- 8 NEW SUBSECTION. 25A. "Restricted use farm pesticide" means
- 9 a restricted use pesticide commonly applied as part of a row
- 10 crop farming operation as listed in rules adopted under section
- 11 206.20.
- 12 NEW SUBSECTION. 26A. "School" means a public or private
- 13 school that provides facilities for teaching any grade from
- 14 kindergarten through grade twelve.
- 15 Sec. 2. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **206.31A** Application of pesticides in
- 16 proximity to child care facility or school.
- 1. A person shall not apply a restricted use farm pesticide
- 18 within twenty-five feet from the real property comprising a
- 19 child care facility or school between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
- 20 Monday through Friday.
- 21 2. a. The department shall adopt rules adjusting the
- 22 requirements described in subsection 1 based on the risk of
- 23 exposure to the drift by children or adults present at a
- 24 child care facility or school, which may include any of the
- 25 following:
- 26 (1) The period when children or adults ordinarily
- 27 congregate or do not ordinarily congregate on the real
- 28 property.
- 29 (2) The weather or climate conditions existing at the time
- 30 of application.
- 31 (3) The type of restricted use farm pesticide used.
- 32 (4) The type of pesticide application equipment used.
- 33 (5) The application method used.
- 34 b. The department may adjust the separation distance
- 35 requirement described in subsection 1, from zero to one

- 1 thousand twenty feet based on the risk factors described in 2 paragraph \tilde{a} .
- 3 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 6 BILL'S PROVISIONS. This bill amends the "Pesticide Act
- 7 of Iowa" in Code chapter 206, administered and enforced
- 8 by the department of agriculture and land stewardship, by
- 9 prohibiting a person from applying a restricted use farm
- 10 pesticide, as classified by the department, within 25 feet from
- 11 the real property comprising a child care facility or K-12
- 12 school between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- 13 However, the department is required to adopt rules adjusting
- 14 those requirements based on the risk of exposure to the drift
- 15 by children or adults present at a child care facility or
- 16 school.
- 17 APPLICABLE PENALTY. A person violating the bill's
- 18 provisions is guilty of a serious misdemeanor. A serious
- 19 misdemeanor is punishable by confinement for no more than one
- 20 year and a fine of at least \$315 but not more than \$1,875.
