Almaden Ranch plan not in Green Vision

The proposed Almaden Ranch Shopping Center is inconsistent with San Jose's Envision 2040 General Plan in creating "neighborhood villages" and also contradicts Mayor Chuck Reed's San Jose Green Vision.

Building a highly auto-oriented project within walking distance of light rail will make the 43-acre site the same old swath of surface parking spaces and big-box retail.

San Jose needs to lead the Bay Area in meeting state air-quality standards, reducing greenhouse gas emissions, creating public space, and enabling long-term economic prosperity.

We recommend either improving this development or stopping it altogether until a better option arises.

We have submitted a detailed comment letter to the City Council with many recommendations, including creating a vibrant community plaza and constructing a bridge over Guadalupe Creek so light rail riders can access it.

San Jose can do better.
