

* For every three units weatherized approximately 1,000 gallons of fuel will be saved every year. WMCA produced over 250 units that were weatherized under DOE ARRA Funds, equating to more than <u>80,000</u> gallons a year and over \$300 thousand dollars currently being saved in Franklin County, Maine every year going forward.
