


It is our mission to advocate for, strengthen, and coordinate all resources - private, local, state, and federal - that will assist us in promoting the self-sufficiency and independence of people.

Maine is the oldest state in the nation with a median age of **43.5** (44.4 in Franklin County) — the percentage of our population that is over 65 out weighs every other state at **17%** (18.1% for Franklin County)

LIHEAP 2017

1,849 people applied for HEAP Benefits in the 2016-2017 Heating Season. Of those who applied, 1641 were eligible, 173 were denied and 30 were either withdrawn or voided.
