Veggies For All is a food bank farm that works to relieve hunger by growing vegetables for those in need, while collaborating with partners to distribute and increase access to quality and nutritious food.

Each year we grow *tons* of vibrant, pesticide-free produce that is made available to our most food insecure neighbors -at no cost- through traditional emergency food networks.

Founded by beginning farmers in 2007, we have grown and distributed <u>over 100,000 pounds of</u> <u>vegetables</u> and engaged hundreds of volunteers in thousands of hours of community- based hunger relief.

We are currently working with 10 food pantries to serve 1,500 food insecure Mainers.
