Rate Case Update

Last week the Wyoming Public Service Commission wrapped up seven days of hearings on Rocky Mountain Power's proposed rate increases. As an official intervening party in the case, the Sierra Club was there advocating for company accountability and fairer rates. The Commission will now review the case, including over 3000 public comments, and make a final decision later this month. We'll share updates with you when that happens, and in the meantime, read this editorial from Sierra Club volunteer, Andrew Schneider, on why utility accountability matters.
