# Tuesday, August 10, 2021 7:00 PM to 8:30 PM EDT Conservation Programs at the North Carolina Zoo

Dr. Betsy Roznik and Nell Allen will be speaking about North Carolina Zoo's extensive conservation program. Most Zoo conservation takes place in North Carolina and several places in Africa. They will talk about local Zoo-owned nature preserves for plant and wildlife habitat, amphibian conservation programs like gopher frog breeding for habitats in the Coastal Plan and hellbender monitoring in the NC mountains. Africa work includes programs like putting GPS collars on elephants to ensure they don't destroy farmers' crops, and DNA studies of the endangered Cross River gorilla. Some highlights of conservation at the Zoo itself include the endangered red wolf breeding program, preserving genetic diversity in Zoo animal populations, plus an extensive sustainability program of composting animal waste and recycling.
