## Legal Challenge to Save Gadsden Creek

The SC Environmental Law Center (SCELP) and Friends of Gadsden Creek filed a legal challenge earlier this month seeking to nullify a DHEC permit authorizing the complete



destruction of Gadsden Creek. In what may be the final opportunity to prevent development from filling in one of the last remaining tidal creeks on the Charleston peninsula, SCELP's challenge accuses DHEC of having issued the permit in violation of regulations protecting critical wetlands.
