As you'll see reading the newsletter, there are a number of conservation issues that have our attention. The State Parks effort to turn more of Oceano Dunes into a playground for off-highway vehicles must be stopped. The Integrated Waste Management Authority (IWMA) is preparing to rescind the ban on polystyrene and extended polystyrene products (think foam cups, dinnerware, packaging, etc.) that it passed in 2019 and was scheduled to go into effect on April 9, 2021, a full year after its initial implementation date. We are awaiting publication of the Federal Register notice with the schedule for public comments and meetings that will constitute the process for designating the Chumash Heritage National Marine Sanctuary.

Those are just a few of the things we are working on. We also have been updating our website to make it easier to navigate. New information is posted regularly, so check in often. We also are making greater use of email to inform our members and supporters about important local issues and how and when they can take action.

We are preparing for our annual fundraiser, coming March 17! We have a great lineup of speakers, including Mary Anne Hitt and Michael Brune. Plan to join us!
