Sunday, Sept. 18th, 2-3:30 p.m. Sierra Club Historic Walk: Old Town Paso Robles Guided stroll through downtown Paso Robles past 1880s storefronts, hotels, and a haunted saloon to learn hidden tales of its pioneers. Meet at the corner of Spring and 10th Streets. Leader: Joe Morris, 805-549-0355.

Sunday, October 9, 9:00 a.m. Loop hike through the Irish Hills. Join the leader on this moderate 8-mile hike through the Irish Hills. There will be about 1200 ft. of elevation gain. We will go south to the Waddell Ranch and then up to Ocean View where we will enjoy the view. We'll complete the loop back to the cars, descending Old Prospector on the way. Saturday, October 15, 9:00 a.m. Coon Creek Trail, Montana de Oro State Park, to the old homestead and back along Rattlesnake Trail for ocean views. It is moderate, six mile loop with less than 500 ft elevation gain. Bring water, lunch, windbreaker, hat and dress in layers for varying weather. Sunday, Oct. 23rd, 2-3:30 p.m. Sierra Club Easy Stroll of Montana de Oro State Park. Scenic walk past the Spooner ranch house, native plant garden, and along the bluffs to explore some hidden features of the plant life, beach coves, and early human habitation.
