Eligibility: Any individual or organization within the Tampa Bay area is eligible to apply

for funds: Hillsborough, Pasco, Hernando and Citrus counties.

Criteria: Preference will be given to Sierra Club members, or to individuals or groups

with a background in conservation and sustainability. Preference will be given to projects within our membership territory or which will benefit the Sierra Club or the community from an environmental standpoint. Grants will not be distributed for political causes or to support political candidates. Grants will not

be distributed for college tuition payment.

Award Amount Awards are made up to \$500.

Grant Period: No more than one grant will be awarded per year to the same entity.

Application: The application shall be not more than two pages in length (single spaced) and

shall contain the following information:

Name of Person/Organization submitting the proposal.

- Name, address, and phone number and email of the contact person.
- Project description.
- How the grant project would benefit the community and/or Sierra

Club.

- Proposed detailed budget not to exceed \$500.
- Duration of project and projected completion date.

Dates: Awards will normally be made by check within (30) days after the application is

received.

Requirements: Recipients are required to present a report when the project is completed.
