Galesburg Lake Plans Would Destroy Over 600 Acres

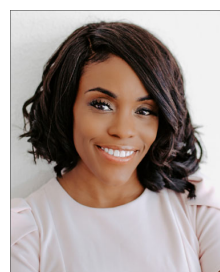

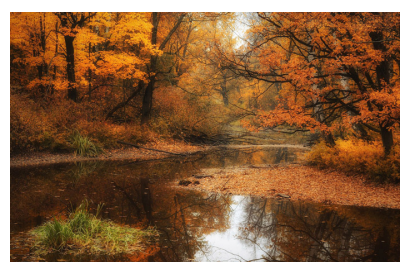
