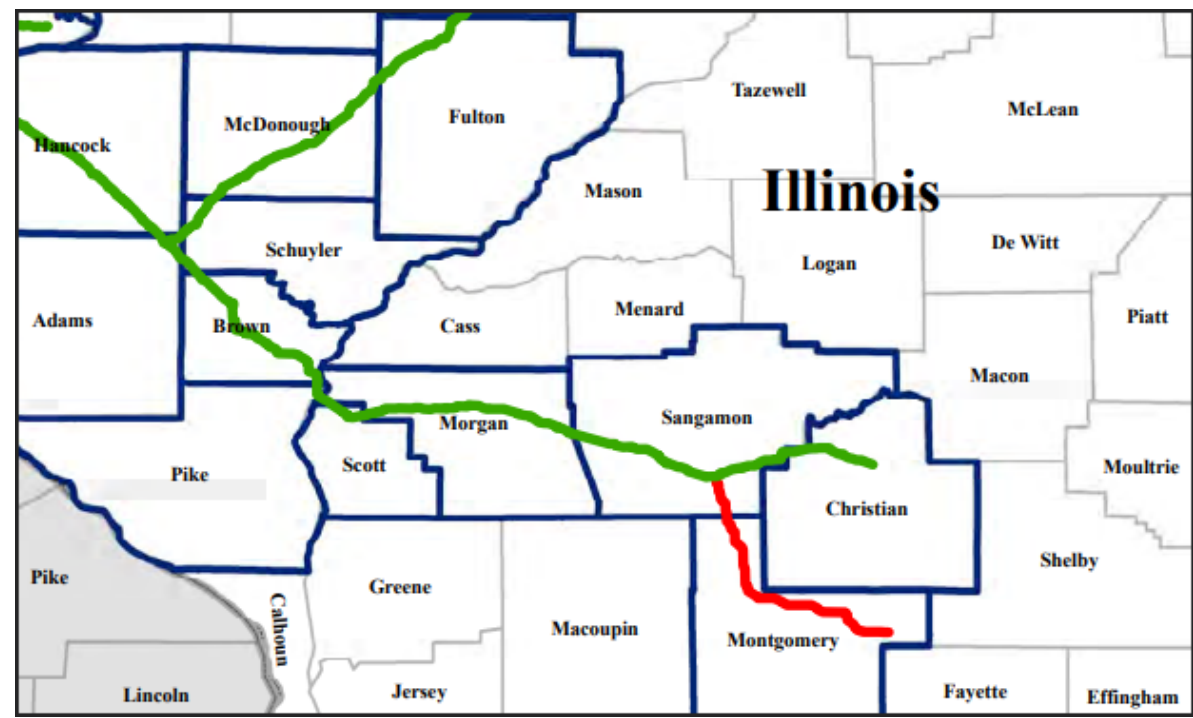




### CO2 Pipeline and Sequestration Companies Keeping Essential Information from Public View

In the United States, the related Wolf Carbon Solutions company in coordination with ADM, is proposing a 280 mile long CO2 pipeline which will run through much more populated areas. 
