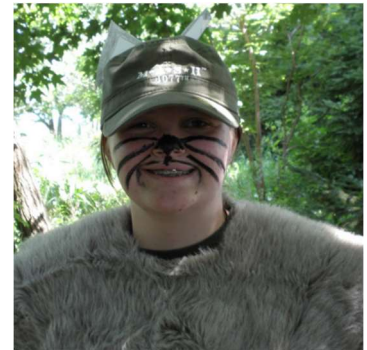
Directions
