Hiking Essentials: Hat, Water, Sun Protection, Lunch, Layered Clothing, Sturdy Shoes/Boots

May 9, 2015, Saturday, Piety Hill Loop Trail (1A, HE). The Piety Hill Loop Trail starts at the Cloverdale trailhead on Cloverdale Road north of Clear Creek Road. Meet at the Sav Mor shopping center parking lot on Westside Road off Hwy 273 close to the Carl's Junior at 8:30 am to carpool, as parking for cars is limited at the trailhead. Liability waivers will be available for signing. Bring a lunch and water and wear appropriate footwear. There is an outhouse but no drinking water at the trailhead. This 3.85 mile easy to moderate trail has gentle hills, and lovely views of the Sacramento Valley to the east and Clear Creek Canyon from the offshoot overlook trail. We will discuss some of the restorative work done to the Lower Clear Creek Watershed and the history of Piety Hill itself. The hike should last 2.5 hours. Limited to 15 people. May 22-May 25 Car Camp/Day Hikes (1A, WCE). Friday-Monday Memorial Day weekend road trip to Dry Valley Rim & Smoke Creek Desert 25 mi. east of Susanville. Will group car camp @ 2 different locations depending on road/weather conditions. Low mountains, flowing desert creek along old Noble's trail; Bring camera, paints, binoculars; wildlife & wildflowers guaranteed. Participants are expected to camp/hike as a group; must bring all personal camping gear, water (2 gals./day/person), food, clothes for all conditions, & cook for yourself. Weather could range from 20s to 70s-rare late season snow possible. Leisurely short hikes cross-country on rocky uneven ground; sturdy boots a must. Rendezvous Honey Lake Wildlife Area/Fleming Unit hunter's camp Friday night or Saturday before 10 a.m. Limit 10 participants. June 6, 2015, Saturday, Wintu Loop Trail (1A,WE). We will hike the Wintu Loop Trail from Swasey Recreation Area west of Redding. Meet at 8:30 am behind the Chase Bank at the Shasta Mall on Dana Drive for carpooling or at the trailhead at 9:00 am. Liability forms will be available for signing. Bring a snack or lunch and water and wear appropriate footwear. There is a restroom but no drinking water at the trailhead. This is a moderate 2.8 mile hike with a climb, and is not recommended for small children. We'll traverse through manzanita, chaparral and forest. On a clear day, there are beautiful views of Mt Shasta and Mt Lassen. This area is very close to Redding and yet has a wonderfully wild feeling to it. The hike should last about 1.5 hours.
