



OLYMPIC PENINSULA SEPTEMBER 24-27

Step into the unmatched diversity and splendor of Olympic National Park. Follow untamed rivers flowing from glacier-capped peaks through valleys of old-growth forests, and traverse the vast interior of this spectacular wilderness.

ACCOMODATIONS

Stay at historic Lake Crescent Lodge on the shores of a pristine glacial lake. With walks, hikes, and water activities at its doorstep, it's a perfect base camp from which to explore. Dinner at the Lodge's certified green restaurant offers stunning views.

ACTIVITIES

- Explore the lush Hoh Rain Forest and spectacular Hurricane Ridge, with various levels of hiking to accommodate all abilities;
- Visit the Elwha River, site of the largest ecosystem restoration project in U.S. history;
- Speak with Sierra Club staff and local partners about this landmark effort as well as current actions underway to protect additional land and rivers throughout the park.

TRANSPORTATION

Guests arrange their own airfare to and from Seattle-Tacoma International Airport. Transportation will be provided for the three-hour drive to Lake Crescent as well as all day-trips.
